

## EP315 MICROPROCESSOR LAB

### PROJECT CLOSEOUT and GRADING

Please note the following things as you complete your projects and bring them in for demonstration.

1. **All group members must be present at the time of the project presentation/demo. They will be interviewed and graded individually. So please co-ordinate your schedules.**
  
2. **PROJECT PROPOSAL:** The completed project must be accompanied by a revised version of your project proposal. You will probably have forgotten the proposal you submitted originally – many of you ended up building things somewhat different from what you planned. That's fine. Just bring a neat one or two page document which has:
  - a. The implementation of your ideas with a block diagram.
  
  - b. Gives detailed specifications for the system – its inputs, outputs and the tests you will use to determine it functions properly.
  
  - c. A statement of how the work was divided between the group members (use arrows on the block diagram to point this out). The partitioning of the project should be into separately testable subsystems – with each group member responsible for one of the subsystems.

The project document forms a part of your grade, and will be filed for posterity, so make it neat!

3. **Bill of Materials:** Please bring a list of items you bought while building your project and outstanding receipts if any.
  
4. **Presentation scheduling:** Please co-ordinate project demos with Mr. Nitin Pawar, Ms. Swapnali and myself (give us at least a half-day notice!).
